Sheriff Scott Kent announced today that preventative measures have been updated at the Sheriff's Office due to the potential for coronavirus (COVID-19) exposure. Sheriff Kent has suspended the following activities in the Sheriff's Office:

- Inmate visitation
- ALPHA 12-step programs
- Bible Study
- Gideons prayer group
- Cognitive restructuring classes
- Anger Management classes
- Child Care classes

Only essential county employees, attorneys, necessary contractors and those with appointments will be allowed into the jail after going through a screening process and a temperature reading in the lobby.

CCW applications will be processed by appointment only on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Those wishing to apply for or renew their CCW license, should call the number listed above and ask for CCW Officer Kerry McNutt. (no walk-ins will be accepted at this time)

Webchecks and background fingerprinting will also be processed by appointment only on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Those wishing to have fingerprinting done, should call the number listed above and asked for Deputy Eric Johns. (no walk-ins will be accepted at this time)

"I am committed to keeping my staff healthy so that we can continue to provide you with the professional response, that you expect from us."

"There have been no cases of coronavirus at the Justice Center and we are taking proactive preventative measures to minimize exposure. Only those who feel it is necessary should come to the Sheriff's Office while I have these restrictions in effect. My Administrative Staff and I will continue to re-evaluate our position and will do our best to keep you informed as changes are made. Thank you for your understanding." said Kent.
